LETTER TO OWNERS/OPERATORS NO 2425 ITALIAN CIVIL AVIATION AUTHORITY (ENAC) – NOTICE OF UNAPPROVED PARTS DISTRIBUTED BY MERIDIANA

The attached unapproved parts notification has been received from the Italian Civil Airworthiness Authority. Operators and maintenance organisations should review the information and follow the recommendations.

Suspect parts, which have been installed on aircraft, must be dealt with appropriately. Suspect parts in the inventory must be quarantined to prevent installation on aircraft until the parts provenance and airworthiness state is confirmed. Where suspect or unairworthy parts are identified, the CAA should be informed using a Mandatory Occurrence Report (Airworthiness Notice 19 & 78 refers), quoting this Letter to Owners/Operators number.
