## **European Legislation**

- Council Regulations (EC) are adopted by the the European Parliament and the Council of the European Union.
- Council Regulations are legally binding in all Member States.
- Council Regulations establish objectives and essential requirements.



## **European Legislation**

- Commission Regulations (EC) are adopted by the European Commission and establish the implementing rules required by the Basic Regulation.
- Commission Regulations are legally binding in all Member States.
- Commission Regulations establish the working rules and requirements.
- Commission Directives require National legislation to introduce the requirements

## **EASA Functions**

#### **Article 15 Airworthiness**

- Agency directly responsible for:
  - Issue of type certificates
  - Issue environmental certificates
  - Issue of airworthiness directives
  - Design organisation approvals
  - Non-EU located maintenance and production organisations
  - EU located production organisations, if requested by Member States concerned

## **EASA Functions**

#### **Article 15 Airworthiness**

- Member States responsible for issue of:
  - C of A/ARC to individual aircraft
  - Maintenance Management Organisation
  - Maintenance organisation approval
  - Production organisation approval
  - Maintenance training approval
  - Personnel certificates (Part 66)
  - Maintenance programme approval
  - Continuing Airworthiness oversight
