





- This document provides an example to the new look Part-FCL licence, with particular reference to the Light Aircraft Pilot Licence (LAPL).
- It should be noted that this licence is not ICAO compliant, so cannot be used outside the EASA Member States without the formal permission of the National Aviation Authority of the State you wish to fly in.
- The new EASA Part-FCL licence document is printed on A4 security paper, with 8 pages to each side, those pages not used are marked 'Intentionally Blank'. The licence document folds into A7, the CAA will provide a new licence cover on initial issue of a licence in the new format




