Be READY

- R Follow RECOGNISED processes, procedures, and practices at all times.
- **ENGAGE** in positive conversations about safety and use your organisation's reporting systems, if you need to.
- Stay **AWARE** of your surroundings. You and your colleagues may have forgotten how hazardous the ramp can be.
- Always consider the consequences of your **DECISIONS**. Do not do anything you have not been trained for.
- These are challenging times, so think about your wellbeing, that of your colleagues, and others **YOU** interact with.

Stay SAFE

- SPEAK UP if you have concerns about anything you see or experience.
- Think carefully about your **ACTIONS**. Remain professional and pay attention to your tasks. Minimise distractions and do not become complacent.
- Take your time, things might not be as **FAMILIAR** to you as they were and that's to be expected. Plan ahead and if unsure, ask for help.
- Be prepared to learn **EVERY DAY**. Operations may be different in the coming months.
