

APPLICATION TO OVERFLY THE UK WITH DANGEROUS GOODS AND/OR MUNITIONS OF WAR

Submission instructions can be found at the end of the form.

1 This form only applies to those requests to carry dangerous goods and/or munitions of war when overflying the UK where either the UK Air Navigation Order, AIR-OPS or the ICAO Technical Instructions indicate that they may only be carried with a prior approval or an exemption, or where they do not comply with the normal requirements of the Technical Instructions. All parts of this form must be completed. If there is insufficient space to list all items, they can be listed on a separate sheet.

2 Application for an approval or exemption should be made at least 15 working days before the date of the flight on which the dangerous goods/munitions of war are to be carried. Completed application must be submitted by e-mail to dgo@caa.co.uk.

5 REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION

Please ensure that the following documents (if applicable) are included with the application form, otherwise it may delay the granting of the UK approval/exemption:

- **Confirmation of representation:** if the person shown in Section 1 is not the operator of the aircraft, then confirmation in writing must be provided with this application that the operator agrees for that person to act on their behalf.
- **Copy of Dangerous Goods Approval:** if the operator shown in Section 2 does not hold a UK CAA Dangerous Goods Approval and is not an EASA-OPS operator, a copy of the Dangerous Goods Approval issued by the State of the operator must accompany the application.
- **Copy of Dangerous Goods Exemption:** a copy of the exemption issued by the State of Origin as shown in Section 4 MUST accompany the application, without exception.
- **Risk Assessment**: a robust risk assessment identifying potential hazards and allocating a risk score reflecting the likelihood and severity of a potential incident must accompany the application.
- Air Operator Certificate: a copy of the AOC and Operations Specifications must be provided.
- Third Country Operator: a copy of the UK TCO certificate must be provided.
