Reason:	A batch of non-optimum stainless steel alloy entered the production process for a limited time. This can result in a reduction of strength and cracking of the affected parts.

Compliance/Action:	<ul> <li>Complete the inspection actions in accordance with the procedures in sections 4.1 and 4.2 of Bulletin BMAA SB 2462 Issue 2 within the next 5 flight hours or by 31 January 2014, whichever comes first.</li> <li>Note: there is no need to repeat these inspections if they were performed for issue 1 of this Service Bulletin.</li> <li>At the next Permit to Fly revalidation inspection (on, or after, the 31 January 2014) the BMAA Inspector must confirm that Service Bulletin BMAA SB 2462 Issue 2 has been complied with. This may be confirmed by checking that compliance with the Service Bulletin has been properly recorded in the airframe logbook (see Section 6 of the Service Bulletin).</li> </ul>
