Background:

STC Twenty One Limited (UK.21J.0198) has notified UK CAA of its intent to surrender STC EASA.A.S.02606. As part of this process, this design approval was first suspended through UK CAA SkyWise bulletin. Whilst a transfer was encouraged, no response related to SkyWise bulletin was received. Therefore, the STC below is now surrendered.

Additional Remarks:

Affected aircraft on the UK register may continue to operate until an unsafe condition has been identified, at which point the Airworthiness Directive (AD) process will control the necessary actions. No subsequent embodiments of the design approval or release on Airworthiness Release Certificate (Form 1) of manufactured parts/articles are permitted. Aircraft operating on other registers may be subject to restrictions by the respective aviation authority.
