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




EASA organisation chart






Production in EASA – Flight Standards

Number of POA issued by EASA:

- 41 POA (non-EU)
- 2 Single POA (Airbus, Airbus Helicopters)
- 8 applications in process

Locations (out of EU):

- 8 in China
- 7 in Turkey
- 5 in Russia
- 4 in Japan, Singapore
- 2 in India, Australia
- 1 in Israel, UAE, South Africa, Thailand, USA,
 Philippines, New Zealand, Taiwan, Vietnam

Scope of work:

- A1,A2 (Aircraft) 2 POAs
- A3, A4 (Helicopters) 1 POA
- B1 (Engines) 1 POA
- C1,C2 (Parts, Appliances) 43POAs



EASA POA and BREXIT

- → EASA offered specific option to apply for EASA organisation approvals before the BREXIT date
- → EASA received and managed 120 POA applications from UK

EASA WILL ISSUE POAs (and other approvals) ONLY IN THE EVENT OF A NO-DEAL SCENARIO ON THE DAY FOLLOWING THE DATE ON WHICH THE UK WITHDRAWS FROM THE EU

EASA Part 21 POA application (standard)

- → <u>Pre-application package</u>: shall be clearly stated and applicant can submit to <u>samuel.pernet@easa.europa.eu</u> or <u>jiri.novy@easa.europa.eu</u> directly.
- → Initial application package must be sent by mail to EASA or electronically to applicant.services@easa.europa.eu mailbox and must contain :
 - → EASA Form 50 including the turnover, (available in EASA website http://easa.europa.eu/document-library/application-forms?search=&date_filter[min]&date_filter[max]&&page=3)
 - → Detailed scope of approval and justification of the POA,
 - → Contact person in the organisation,
 - → Outline of the Production Organisation Exposition (organisational structure, functions and responsibilities),
 - → **DO/PO arrangement(s)** (including information on Direct Delivery Authorisation) or an evidence that the applicant holds or has applied for an approval of the applicable design data,
 - → Certificate of Incorporation with translation to English, with the name and address of the company,
 - → If possible, EASA Form 4 for responsible managers,
 - → If possible, **POA eligibility checklist** filled in.



Fees & charges

- → Information on Fees & Charges is available on EASA Website: http://easa.europa.eu/regulations
- → Fees and Charges Regulation:
 - COMMISSION REGULATION (EC) No 319/2014
- → Fees for POA:
 - Based on declared turnover
 - Initial application fee
 - Continued surveillance fee (annual) → request for review of turnover sent every year 1 month before the invoice's issuance
 - Travel cost out of EU (including travel time)
