

**UK CAA Minimum Requirements for Certification of
Aeromedical Examiners (AMEs)**

Class 2 AME (for Class 2 and LAPL private pilot medical examinations)	
Medical Licence to Practise	Valid unrestricted full UK General Medical Council Registration with a Licence to Practise OR If overseas, equivalent medical registration/licence with the National Medical Regulator in the country of practice
Higher Medical Training (CCST or equivalent)	On the UK GMC (or equivalent) Specialist Register in General Practice or a recognised Clinical Specialty
Aviation Medicine/ Flying Experience	Diploma in Aviation Medicine (King's College London or University of Otago only) OR One year of full-time (or equivalent) Aviation Medicine practice, e.g. care of aircrew/ATCOs, air ambulance work, regulator OR Pilot's Licence or equivalent OR Introduction to Multi-crew Jet Operations Course
Aviation Medicine Training Courses (Passes gained in final exams)	Basic Course in Aviation Medicine*
UK CAA Administration Training Course (following successful application)	UK CAA AME Administration Course

*Diploma in Aviation Medicine (King's College London or University of Otago) is considered to meet the training requirements of both the Basic and the Advanced Courses in Aviation Medicine.

Extension of privileges from Class 2 to Class 1 AME (for Class 2 and LAPL private pilot, Class 1 professional pilot and EU Class 3 ATCO medical examinations)	
Aviation Medicine Training Courses (Passes gained in final exams)	Advanced Course in Aviation Medicine*
Aeromedical examinations Performed	At least 30 within preceding 5 years
Practical training in AeMC or under Authority (AMS) supervision	Minimum of 1 day of training in aeromedical examinations and assessments at an Aeromedical Centre (AeMC)

*Diploma in Aviation Medicine (King's College London or University of Otago) is considered to meet the training requirements of both the Basic and the Advanced Courses in Aviation Medicine.
