Spaceport

- We are assessing 2 applications for spaceports
- We are also in pre-application engagement with another 3
- In the next 6 months we expect to receive 2 to 3 more applications for spaceport

Range

- We are assessing 2 applications for range licences
- We are also in pre-application engagement with another 3
- In the next 6 months we expect to receive 2 more applications for range





The number of applications received is ramping up

Launch

- We are assessing 2 applications for launch
- We are also in pre-application engagement with another 3 operators
- In the next 6 months we expect to receive 3 to 4 applications for launch

ANO

- We are assessing applications for 2 ANO rocket permissions
- We are also in pre-application engagement with 2 operators
- In the next 6 months we expect to receive 2 applications for ANO permissions

Insights from our first 6 months as the UK's space regulator

Feedback welcome	We have received some good feedback, please continue to let us know what works well and what needs improving, ensuring it is provided to us (CAA) and not other agencies						
We continue to improve	We have listened to your feedback, we have already made changes to our systems						
Use generic/typical data or Information	Whilst we recognise that data, people and processes are often in development at the point of application, please use generic/typical data or information so the application can continue. We expect a degree of iteration during the licensing process.						
Preparation & quality reduces application time	We have seen applications that have appeared to have been rushed, and it is essential enough time is planned for information & evidence to be complete and of sufficient quality to avoid applications being put on hold						



It is essential that enough time is allocated to prepare a good set of documents and evidence for submission with the application

Licensing processing time is a guide, it could be slightly shorter or longer dependent on the complexity of the application and the quality of the submitted documents and evidence, we will always process your application as fast as possible, planning with shorter timescales is at your own risk.

Assessment of Environmental Effects

- Considers the potential environmental effects of launch activities and the proportionate steps to avoid, mitigate or offset these impacts
- Sets the maximum number of launches that can take place over the course of a year that can be carried out in an environmentally sustainable manner.
- Approach is aligned with Environmental Impact Assessments

- Early engagement with the CAA during pre-application
