1 List of late renewing ATOL holders who no longer hold an ATOL at 1 April 2022

- 1.1 This document contains a list of firms who have applied to renew their licences, but have failed to do so as at midnight 31 March 2022. In some cases the CAA has yet to reach a decision on their application, in others the CAA has decided to grant the application from the date on which the firm provides the items required to grant the renewal. Inclusion on this list does not necessarily mean that the CAA has doubts as to the firm's financial resources.
- 1.2 Until the firms appearing on this list have renewed their licence, they are not permitted to advertise or accept bookings or payments unless they are acting as an agent on behalf, and with the authority, of a disclosed ATOL holder or are acting as an airline ticket agent.
