**The Civil Aviation Authority (Air Navigation) Directions 2023, Direction 6
Airspace Change Proposal: Consideration of Spaceport 1 Scolpaig North Uist
(ACP-2021-012)**

Thank you for your email of 6 January 2025 to the Department, enclosing a copy of CAP3077 which set out the assessment by the Civil Aviation Authority (CAA) of whether the 'Consideration of Spaceport 1 Scolpaig North Uist' airspace change proposal (ACP) met the call-in criteria as set out in Direction 6 of the Air Navigation Directions 2023.
