

Invasive coronary angiogram reports

All invasive coronary angiogram (ICA) reports should contain the information below, with standard angiographic images of coronary vessels provided / available in addition to the written report. Copies of the angiographic DICOM dataset (that allows visualisation in standard clinical workstations) should be available on request by the CAA Medical Department (with any fee for this paid by the applicant).

ICA report requirements

All individual lesions are to be reported and an aggregate stenosis (summation of every lesion) should be provided to give total overall stenosis burden. This includes all major epicardial vessels and side branches.

Comment on any coronary ectasia (especially in those with no atheroma)

Fractional flow reserve (FFR) / instantaneous wave free ratio (iFR) values are to be reported when undertaken and provided in the angiogram report.
