

General

Before completing this form please read the Guidance Notes.

Aircraft Type Ratings are issued by the Civil Aviation Authority in accordance with the provisions of the Air Navigation Order 2016. AIC 137/1993 - The Requirements to obtain a Flight Engineers Licence gives guidance to applicants on the criteria adopted for the issue and variation of a Flight Engineers. licence

Personal Details

The permanent address is the one that will appear on your licence. If you wish the licence returned to an alternative address please complete the correspondence address.

Application and Declaration

Please indicate the Aircraft Rating (type of aircraft) that you have been tested on.

The period of validity of the Certificate of Test in respect of this rating will date from the completing of the tests in Section 5 of this application.

Certificate of Test

The Examiner is to complete the Examiner's

'Satisfactorily' means the applicant is in full control of the panel at all times and that the successful outcome of a procedure, check, action or drill is never in doubt. 'Unassisted' means without verbal prompting or physical assistance with the panel.

Experience as Flight Engineer on Type of Aircraft which applicant wishes included in Aircraft Type Rating

The various items of the test may be carried out at different times but items must have been completed within 6 months preceding the application for the aircraft rating or licence.

Certification of Parts of Aircraft Type Rating Test

Only persons holding a valid Examiners Certificate issued by the Civil Aviation Authority Flight Operations Inspectorate Operator Training Standards may sign Certificates of Test or Certificates of Experience.
