### **Proposed Changes to CAA Scheme of Charges**

# Aircraft Registration, 'E' Conditions Declarations and Registration of Aircraft Mortgages Scheme Enclosure

#### 1 INTRODUCTION

1.1 Details of revisions proposed to apply from 1 April 2019 are shown in red within this Enclosure. Current charges are shown in brackets where direct comparison is possible. Where no change to a price is proposed then the current charge will only be shown.

#### 2 CHARGES INDEX

The following Charges Index sets out the charge headings under this Scheme and refers to the page where each section commences:

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#### 3 CHARGES (Amended)

#### 3.1 Certificate of registration of an aircraft

3.1.1 Upon making an application for the grant of a Certificate of Registration of an aircraft, other than such an application as is referred to in paragraph 3.1.3 below, the applicant shall pay a charge in accordance with the following table:

Aircraft in respect of which application is made	Charge Payable
Balloons and aircraft having an MTWA not exceeding 15,000 kg	<mark>£73</mark> (£71)
Aircraft having MTWA exceeding 15,000 kg	<mark>£146</mark> (£142)

- 3.1.2 Upon making an application to reserve an out of sequence registration mark for an aircraft, the applicant shall pay a charge of £158 (£154) for each six-month period of reservation or part thereof.
- 3.1.3 Upon making an application for the grant of a Certificate of Registration of an aircraft specifying an out of sequence registration mark, the applicant shall pay the appropriate charge payable under paragraph 3.1.1 above plus a charge of £316 (£308).
- 3.1.4 Upon making an application for notification whether a specified aircraft is or has been registered in the United Kingdom, the applicant shall pay in respect of each specified aircraft a charge of £26 (£25).

#### 3.2 Declaration concerning the operation of experimental aircraft under 'E' Conditions (Amended)

- 3.2.1 Upon making a declaration to the CAA signed by an E conditions Competent Person for an aircraft not exceeding 2,000kg MTOM<sup>1</sup> to be operated under 'E' Conditions, the person making the declaration shall pay, in respect of each specified aircraft, a charge of £54 (£53).
- 3.2.2 Upon expiration of the previous Declaration and should the trial need to continue, the person making the declaration, on making a supplementary declaration to the CAA to amend the flight test period, shall pay to the CAA, in respect of each specified aircraft in the declaration, a charge of £54 (£53).

#### 3.3 **Registration of aircraft mortgages**

- 3.3.1 Upon making an application for the registration of a mortgage of an aircraft, the applicant shall pay:
  - a) on an aircraft having an MTWA not exceeding 5,700 kg, a charge of £184 (£180);
  - b) on an aircraft having an MTWA exceeding 5,700 kg but not exceeding 15,000 kg, a charge of £365 (£356);
  - on an aircraft having an MTWA exceeding 15,000 kg but not exceeding 50,000 kg, a charge of £607 (£593);
  - d) on an aircraft having an MTWA exceeding 50,000 kg, a charge of £1,093 (£1,067).
- 3.3.2 Upon making an application for the registration of a mortgage of more than one aircraft and providing the applications are submitted together, the applicant shall pay a charge calculated as follows:
  - a) for the heaviest aircraft, a charge calculated in accordance with sub-paragraph 3.3.1 above; and
  - b) for each additional aircraft, a charge of £184 (£180).
- 3.3.3 Upon making an application for the registration of a priority notice relating to a contemplated mortgage of an aircraft, the applicant shall pay:
  - a) on an aircraft having an MTWA not exceeding 15,000 kg a charge of £54 (£53);
  - b) on an aircraft having an MTWA exceeding 15,000 kg a charge of £108 (£106).
- 3.3.4 Upon making an application for the registration of a change in particulars appearing in the Register, the applicant shall pay a charge of  $\pounds$ 38 ( $\pounds$ 37).
- 3.3.5 Upon making an application to inspect the entries in the Register relating to any one aircraft or for notification whether there are entries in the Register relating to any one aircraft, the applicant shall pay a charge of £31 (£30).
- 3.3.6 Upon making an application for a copy of the entries in the Register, the applicant shall pay a charge of  $\pounds$ 31 ( $\pounds$ 29).

#### 3.4 **Exemptions**

Upon making an application for an exemption from Article 30(2) of the Order (nationality and registration marks), the applicant shall pay a charge of £31 (£30).

#### 3.5 Irrevocable De-Registration and Export Request Authority (IDERA)

Upon making an application to the CAA to record an IDERA in respect of a specified aircraft, the applicant shall pay to the CAA a charge of  $\pounds108$  (£105) in respect of each aircraft which is the subject of the IDERA.

#### 3.6 **Copies of documents**

Upon making an application for the issue by the CAA of a copy or replacement of a document issued under Articles 25 - 31 of the Order, the applicant shall pay a charge of  $\pounds 49$  ( $\pounds 48$ ).

#### 4 **DEFINITIONS (Amended)**

- 4.1 For the purposes of this Scheme:
  - a) 'E conditions Person' has the same meaning as in Chapter 3 of Part 1 of Schedule 3 of the Order;
  - b) 'CAA' means the Civil Aviation Authority;
  - c) 'E' Conditions means the conditions set out in Chapter 3 of Part 1 of Schedule 3 of the Order;
  - d) 'IDERA' means an Irrevocable De-Registration and Export Request Authority under Article XIII of the Protocol to the Convention on International Interests in Mobile Equipment Specific to Aircraft Equipment 2001 and The International Interests in Aircraft Equipment (Cape Town Convention) Regulations 2015;
  - e) 'Maximum total weight authorised' (MTWA) in relation to an aircraft means in the case of an aircraft in respect of which a certificate of airworthiness is or has been in force, the maximum total weight authorised in the certificate of airworthiness in force in respect of the aircraft or, if no such certificate is in force, the certificate of airworthiness last in force in respect of that aircraft. In any other case 'maximum total weight authorised' means the maximum total weight authorised of the prototype or modification thereof to which the aircraft in the opinion of the CAA conforms;
  - f) 'The Mortgaging of Aircraft Order' means the Mortgaging of Aircraft Order 1972 and any reference to that Order shall, if that Order be amended or replaced, be taken to be a reference to the Mortgaging of Aircraft Order for the time being in force;
  - g) 'The Order' means the Air Navigation Order 2016 and any reference to an Article or Part of that Order shall, if that Order be amended or revoked, be taken to be a reference to the corresponding provisions of the Order for the time being in force.
- 4.2 All other expressions used in this Scheme shall, unless the context otherwise requires, have the same respective meanings as in the Order.

#### 5. COMMENCEMENT (Amended)

This Scheme will come into operation on 1 April 2019.
