**We had over 400 complete responses to the survey. 60% of respondents of those have used our arrangements.**

**The arrangements which are most frequently used by industry:**

- > USA/FAA
- > European Union/EASA
- > Canada/TCCA

This matches the priorities indicated for the overall import and export markets of UK businesses.

Respondents highlighted interest for importing to and exporting from states in the Asia-Pacific region and requested actions from the CAA to engage with authorities in that region.

- > As underlined by many respondents as important, for the CAA this includes engaging with the EU, EASA and its member states.
- > Respondents support continued engagement between the CAA and EASA and look forward to the time when closer collaboration may be possible.
