Outside these periods the CAA will only consider applications for Foreign Carrier Permits for flights of an emergency nature such as air ambulance or humanitarian relief. B) Wet lease requests by UK Operating Licence and Air Transport Licence holders

DHL Air (UK) Limited has applied to wet lease two Bahraini registered Boeing 767-300F aircraft A9C-DHS and A9C-DHT (or substitute) between 29 March 2026 – 24 October 2026.

The application has been made on the grounds that these leases are necessary on the basis of exceptional needs which cannot reasonably be satisfied through leasing aircraft registered within the United Kingdom or the Community (Article 13(3)(b)(i) of Regulation No 1008/2008).
