A new Foreign Carrier Permit application for flights prior to 17.00 BST on Tuesday, 05 May 2026 **will not** be considered if submitted after 13:00 BST on Thursday, 30 April 2026 until our offices reopen on Tuesday, 05 May 2026.

Outside these periods the CAA will only consider applications for Foreign Carrier Permits for flights of an emergency nature such as air ambulance or humanitarian relief. If you need to make such an application you should call the CAA Duty Office on 03300221500 who will pass calls on to appropriate on-call staff.
