## Appendix A

New subheading - Transitional arrangements for the IMC Rating examination papers.

New paragraphs:

- 7.1.12 Any examinations taken and passed on or before the 10<sup>th</sup> May 2026, using the previous set of examination papers, will be accepted for the issue of the IMC Rating for 24 months validity period from the date of the examination.
- 7.1.13 Any examinations taken and passed on or after the 11<sup>th</sup> May 2026, using the previous set of examination papers, will not be accepted for issue of the IMC Rating and the candidate will be required to retake the examination using the new examination papers.
- 7.1.14 If the candidate has failed an attempt at the examination using the previous set of examination papers on or before the 10<sup>th</sup> May 2026, any subsequent attempts on or after the 11<sup>th</sup> May 2026, must use the new examination papers.
- 7.1.15 Candidates for the IMC Rating can start to use the new examination papers once the Examiner has received them.
