

## Exemption – Aerobility

### THE CIVIL AVIATION (AIR TRAVEL ORGANISERS' LICENSING) REGULATIONS 2012, EXEMPTION PURSUANT TO REGULATION 11

1. The Civil Aviation Authority, in exercise of its powers under Regulation 11(1) of the Civil Aviation (Air Travel Organisers' Licensing) Regulations 2012 ("the Regulations"), exempts Aerobility, registered charity in England and Wales No. 1149629, registered in England No. 08200768 of Cawley Priory, South Pallant, Chichester, West Sussex, PO19 1SY, from the need to hold an Air Travel Organiser's Licence.
2. This exemption is issued subject to the following conditions:
  - It applies only to the making available of flight seats on a trip to view the Aurora to be operated by British Airways from Gatwick Airport and which is scheduled to take place on 24 February 2018;
  - All payments accepted by Aerobility from intended participants on the trip have been or are made by credit card;
3. This exemption will expire on 25 February 2018 unless revoked earlier by the CAA.
