

## **Exemption – The Jewish Agency for Israel**

### **THE CIVIL AVIATION (AIR TRAVEL ORGANISERS' LICENSING) REGULATIONS 2012, EXEMPTION PURSUANT TO REGULATION 11(1)**

(1) The Civil Aviation Authority, in exercise of its powers under Regulation 11(1) of the Civil Aviation (Air Travel Organisers' Licensing) Regulations 2012 ("the Regulations"), exempts The Jewish Agency for Israel ('JAFI') from the need to hold an Air Travel Organiser's Licence.

(2) This exemption is issued subject to the following conditions:

(a) JAFI only makes available flight accommodation as part of JAFI organised trips ("trips") from the United Kingdom to Israel;

(b) promotional material for the trips includes a prominent statement that payments for the trips are not ATOL Protected and the consumer is informed before he or she makes a booking with JAFI that trips are not ATOL protected;

(c) consumer protection for the trips is provided by funds placed in Special Designated Deposit Account 20-95-61 33241793 ("the account") at Barclays Bank PLC ("the Bank");

(d) the signatories to the account are the treasurer, company secretary and chief financial officer of United Jewish Israel Appeal, registered charity in England and Wales No. 1060078 and in Scotland No. Sc 039181, registered in England No. 3295115 of (registered office) 1 Torriano Mews, London, NW5 2RZ ("UJIA"), as appointed by UJIA from time to time;

(e) the Bank acknowledges that it has no right of set-off or combination against the funds in the account until it is closed;

(f) all flights are booked through EI AI except where EL AI is unable to provide flight accommodation;

(g) the account is kept in sufficient funds by UJIA to meet the liabilities to EI AI for flights booked for the trips, as and when they arise;

(h) JAFI provides quarterly reports in a format to CAA's requirements.

(3) This exemption comes into force on 1 August 2017 and will expire on 31 July 2018 unless revoked earlier by the CAA.

(4) In this exemption "ATOL", "the consumer" and "flight accommodation" have the same meanings as in the Regulations.
