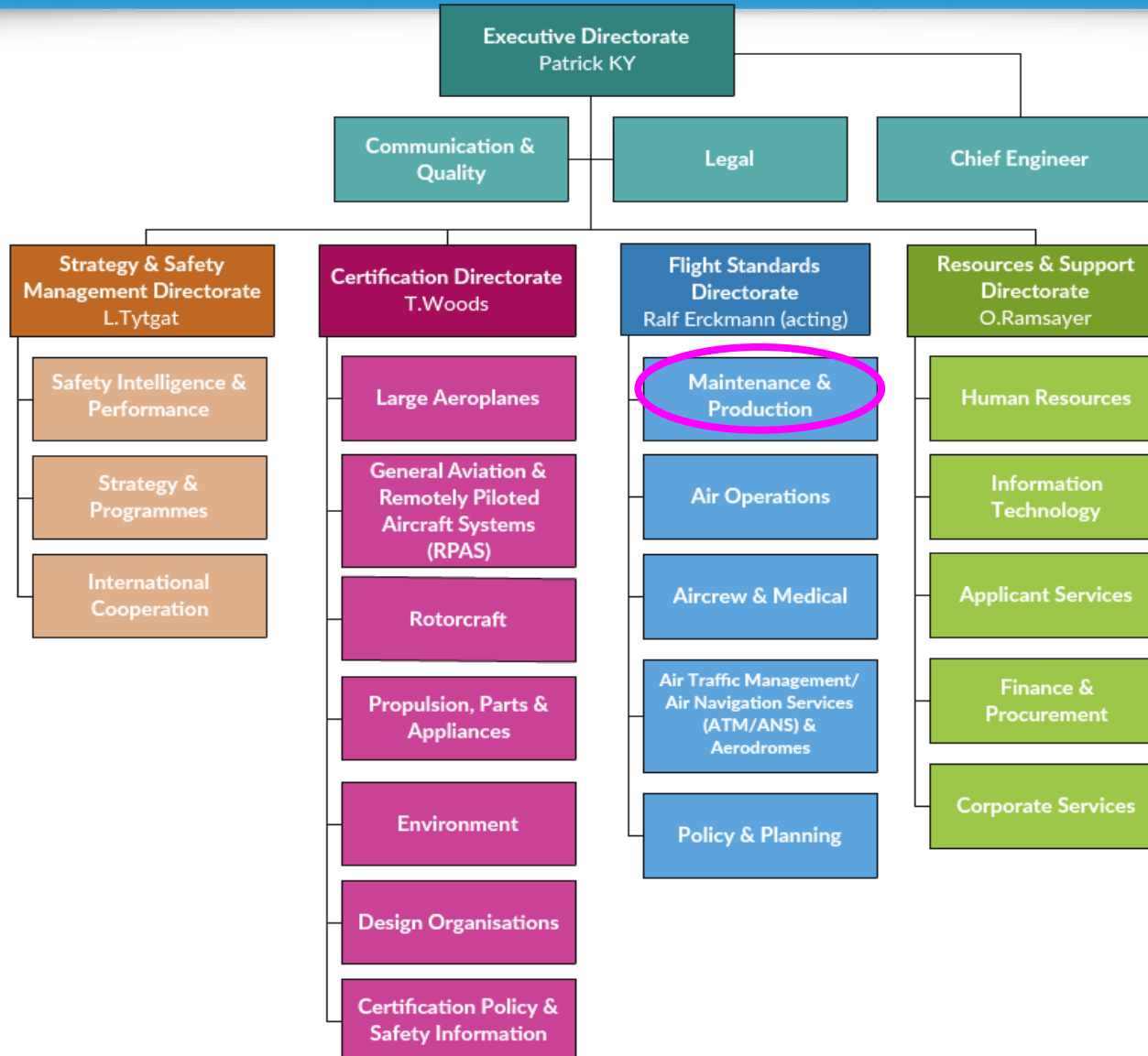

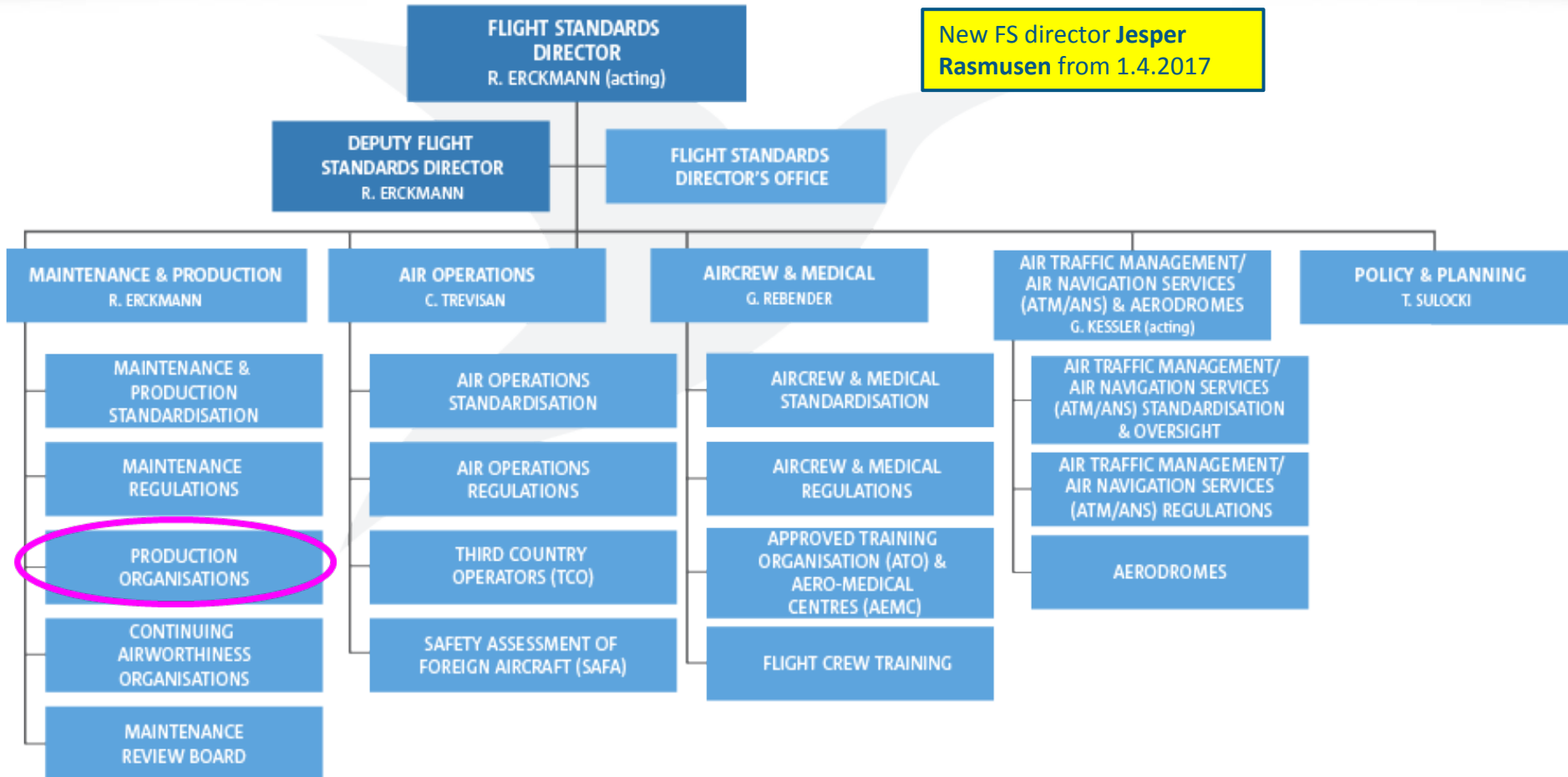

EASA Flight Standards Directorate

- **FS1.1 Maintenance and Production Standardisation Section**
 - POA Standardisation (of EU MS NAAs)
 - Support of International cooperation (BASA, WA)
 - AW Standardisation meetings
- **FS1.3 POA Section**
 - **Non-EU/EASA** Production Organisations (Part 21-Subpart G)
 - EU Production organisations - upon request of EU MS (Airbus POA, Airbus Helicopters POA - under investigation)
 - EASA register of POA's (published on EASA web)
 - Export CofA for EASA POA (Airbus, Diamond in China)
 - Support of International cooperation (BASA, WA)



EASA tasks for POA

EASA Certification Directorate

- Rulemaking activities (748/2012, AMC&GM)
- DOA (coordination)
- Certification (PCM, experts in POA team)

EASA SSM (Strategy & Safety Management) Directorate

- International cooperation Section
 - International activities coordination (BASA, Working arrangements etc.)
- Technical Training Section
 - Training (for EASA, NAA's)



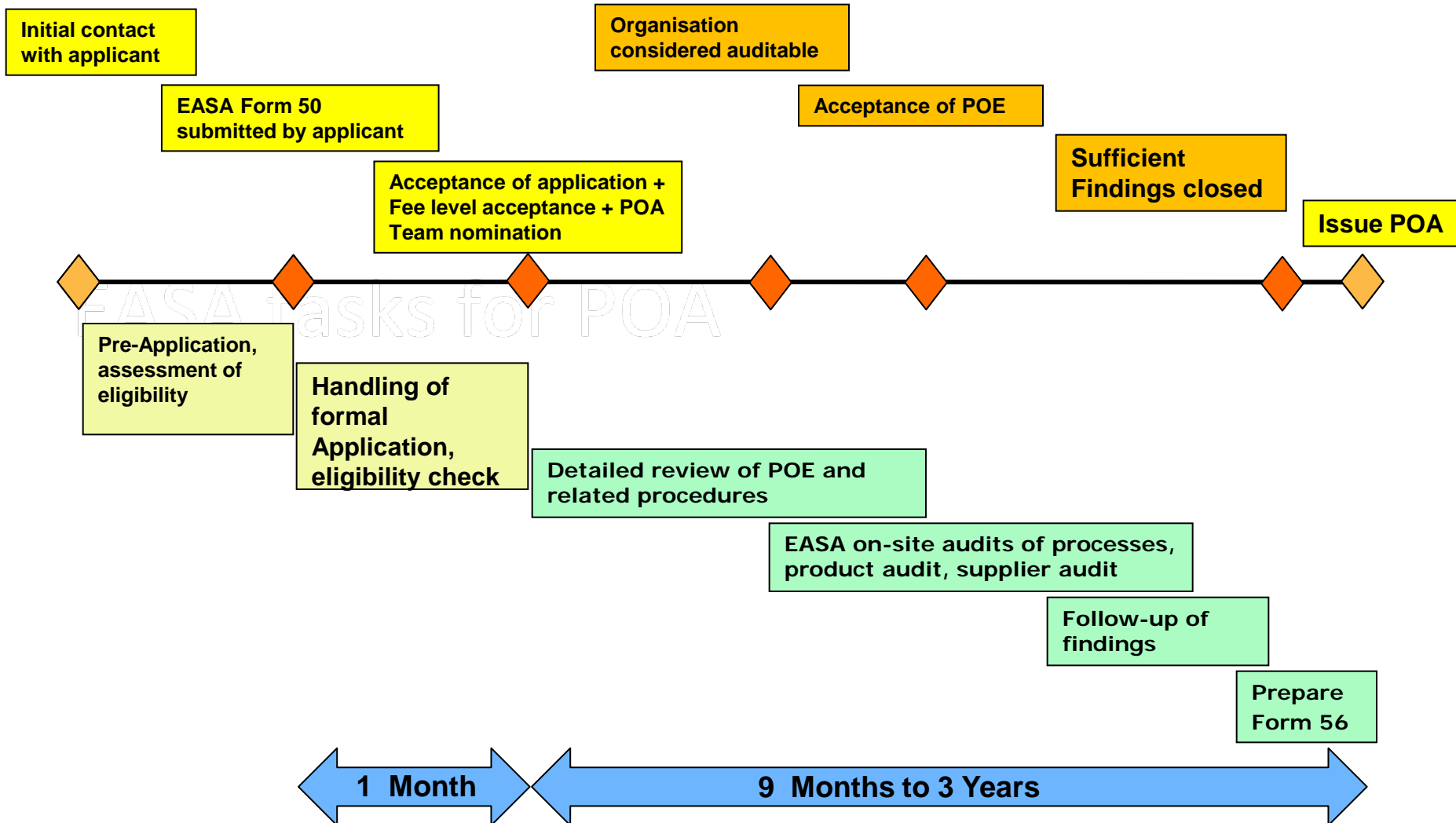
EASA tasks for POA

EASA Resources and Support Directorate

- POA Applications management
- Fees and Charges
- Allocation of tasks (contracts, accreditation)

Continued surveillance principles

- Continued surveillance is basically **planned**
- For each organisation all applicable requirements to be reviewed on a **2 year basis**
- Audit frequency dependent on complexity and size of organisation, but at least **one visit per year** (taking into account risk based approach)
- Audit programme should contain specific **sample product audits** and **supplier audits**
- **EASA Form 56** for POA continuation recommendation **every 2 years**

Actual overview of EASA POA's

Number of POA issued by EASA :

- 37 POA
- 1 Single POA (Airbus)
- 8 applications in process (including Airbus Helicopters SPOA)

Locations:

- 7 in China
- 5 in Russia and Turkey
- 4 in Japan and Singapore
- 2 in India and UAE
- 1 in Israel, South Africa, Thailand, USA, Philippines, Australia, New Zealand, Taiwan

Scope of work:

- A1,A2 (Aircraft) – 2 POAs
- B1 (Engines) – 1 POA
- C1,C2 (Parts, Appliances) – 38 POAs
