<b>Airport Consultative Committee (ACC)</b>		The airport's ACC meets quarterly and provides a regular forum to discuss airport operations and future development. Membership includes representation from the local authorities that fall under the airport's flightpath, Scottish travel trade associations, chambers of commerce and passenger interest groups. Noise is reported on at each meeting.
